Registration dates set

Registration dates have been set for the 2022-23 school year.

No general school fees will be charged this year, although fees may be charged for activities such as band, driver education, clubs and yearbooks.

School insurance will not be on sale during registration.

What students new to a school must bring

All students new to the district must complete a student information form and provide two proofs of residency. **They are asked to bring report cards and any other available records from the school attended last year and will not be allowed to register without the following documents:**

- **Birth certificate** - A copy of the legal **long-form** birth certificate is required. The hospital certificate of birth does not satisfy the requirements of the law. You can obtain a S.C. long form birth certificate 8:30 a.m.-4 p.m. at the nearby regional offices in Rock Hill (803) 909-7300, Winnsboro (803) 635-6481 or Chesterfield (843) 623-2117.
The search fee is \$12, and the request must be made by a parent named on the birth certificate or a legal guardian. Please make sure to have a government or employer picture I.D. with you.
To request a copy by mail, print the application form at <http://www.scdhec.gov/vitalrecords/birth-certificates>. Standard processing time is 2-4 weeks for a \$12 non-refundable fee. Expedited service is \$17.
- **A South Carolina Certificate of Immunization**
South Carolina immunization requirements for school and day care attendance are published annually by DHEC. Students attending school must have a valid South Carolina Certificate of Immunization. For more information on immunizations, please contact your healthcare provider, school nurse or the Lancaster County Health Department (803)286-9948.
 - Minimum requirements may vary some for pre-kindergarten students.
 - Contact DHEC at 1-855-472-3432 to schedule a vaccine appointment
- Copy of **past month's power bill and tax receipt** or **rental lease agreement** as proof of correct resident address.
- If living with relative: you need a **vehicle property tax receipt** with **proof of insurance**, an **state-issued ID with current address** and a **notarized statement**.
- If applicable, submit any **custody orders** for your student.
- If other than parent enrolling, provide **proof of guardianship**.

State age requirements for school attendance

For the 2022-23 school year, the **state of South Carolina requires** that

- each **kindergarten** student be five years of age on or before Sept. 1, 2022,
- each **first-grade** student be six years of age on or before Sept. 1, 2022 and
- each **four-year-old** student must be four years of age on or before Sept. 1, 2022.

Where we have four-year-old programs

Four-year-old programs will operate at Brooklyn Springs, Buford, Clinton, Erwin, Heath Springs, Kershaw, McDonald Green, North elementaries and Southside Early Childhood Center.

Chromebook forms for students in grades PreK-12 will be completed online. You have the option to purchase a Chromebook Protection Plan for \$30. Payment can be made online when you complete the forms or by cash or check at the school on registration day. In addition, you will be prompted to accept the Acceptable Use Regulations for students in grades PreK-12 during online registration.

A.R. Rucker Middle

- **Students new to the district** should register 8 a.m.-12 p.m. and 1-4 p.m. August 2-4 (Tuesday-Thursday). Please bring your child's birth certificate, current S.C. immunization record, two proof of residency (one which must be a copy of property tax statement or rental lease agreement) and be accompanied by parent or legal guardian.

Andrew Jackson High

- **Students who are new** to Andrew Jackson High School and did not attend AJMS need to enroll in the school guidance office. Students must provide previous school information, long form of birth certificate, two proofs of residency (one which must be a copy of property tax information or

rental lease agreement) and must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. New students must also complete the online registration found at <https://www.lancastercsd.com/>. The online registration is found in the section under Applications.

- **All unpaid debts** will be collected during registration.

Andrew Jackson Middle

- **Student registration** on the Parent Portal should be completed before schedules are picked up. Students will not be able to receive their schedule without it. Parents can login to the parent portal account at lancastercsd.powerschool.com/public and select the icon located at the bottom left and update information for each child currently enrolled. Registration must be updated using a computer instead of a mobile device.
- **Returning student registration** updates contacts, medical information including medicare, transportation, and chromebook protection plan. Returning students will also need to provide proof of residency.
- **Students new to the district** should register between 8 a.m.-noon and 1-4 p.m. Aug. 2 or 3. Please bring birth certificate, S.C. immunization record and two proofs of residency (property tax receipt or rental lease agreement) and be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. - **Schedule pick-up for all grades** is from 8 a.m.-noon and 1-4 p.m. Aug. 10 or 11.
- **Open house for 6th grade** students will be held from 5:30 - 7 p.m. August 11.
- **Sixth grade orientation** for students will be held from 8:15 a.m. - 1 p.m. August 12.
- **Open house for 7th and 8th grade** students will be held from 5:30 - 7 p.m. August 16.

Brooklyn Springs Elementary
